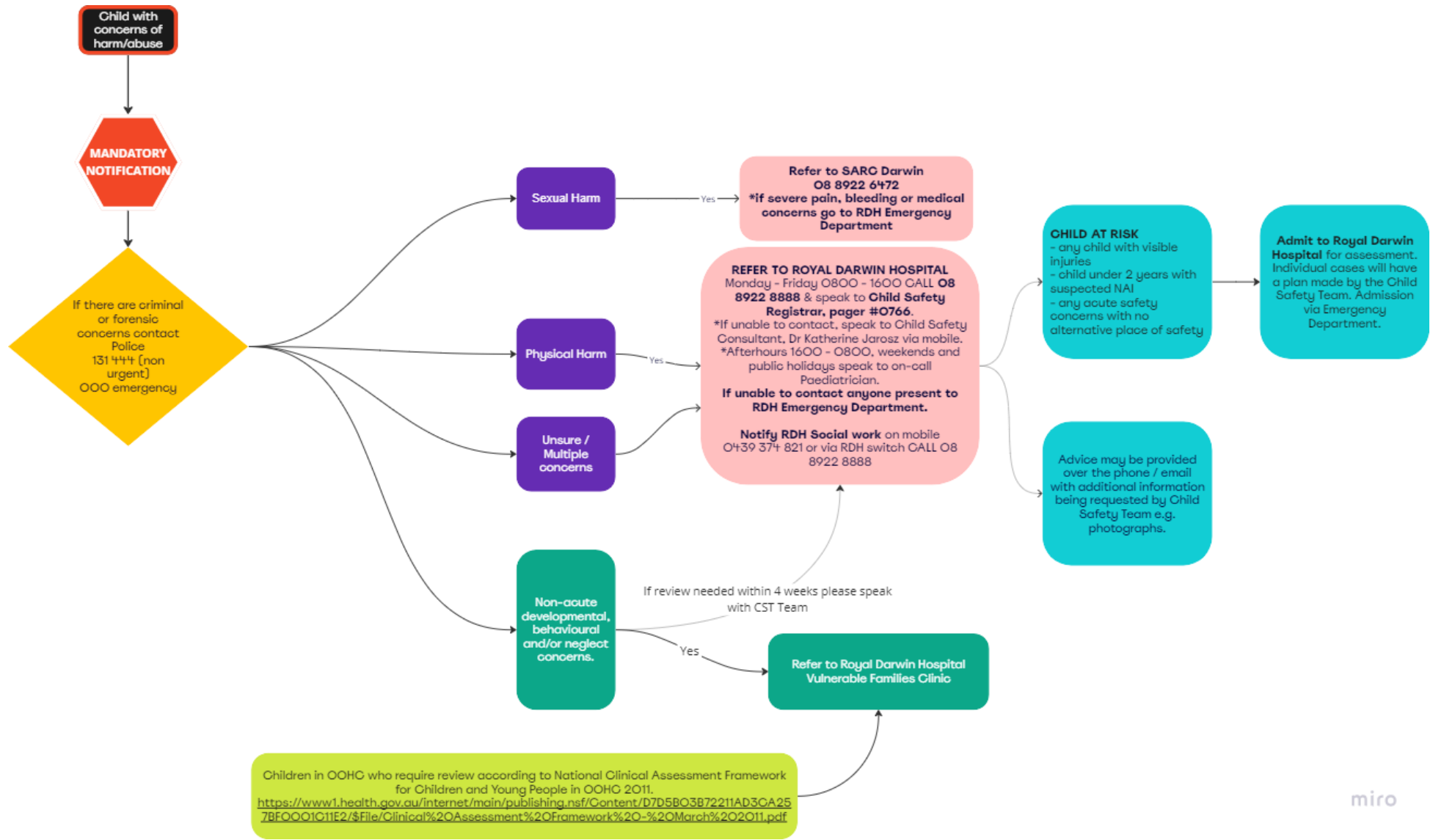

## Mandatory Notifications

In the Northern Territory, everyone has a legal responsibility to report child abuse concerns to Territory Families by making a Mandatory Report. This covers all forms of abuse and neglect and domestic violence. If you have formed a *reasonable belief* that harm has occurred, you must report to Territory Families in one of two ways:

1. Via phone (1800 700 250)
2. Online (<http://internal-childprotectionreport.nt.gov.au>; also accessible via the main page of the Intranet) – preferred method, unless you think the matter requires an urgent (less than 24 hours) response from TF
